New Installations

1. Download the client installer file into a temporary folder.
2. Double-click the file and follow the on screen instructions to complete the installation.

6 Patches

A *patch* is a piece of software that is designed to fix or improve a computer program or its supporting data. These may include repairs to security vulnerabilities or resolution of bugs, and may also improve usability or performance. On the OpenText Knowledge Center you will find two general types of patches. *Hotfixes* are also known as quick-fixes or bug fixes. *Updates* are also known as service packs or service releases.

The following patches must be applied to OpenText™ FirstClass® Client 16.005. OpenText recommends that administrators check the 'FC Update Service' container on their FirstClass server or the OpenText Knowledge Center (<https://knowledge.opentext.com/>) for any patches or documentation updates that may have been posted after this release.

6.1 Hotfixes

Hotfixes are small patches that address software issues. Typically, there is no new functionality in a hotfix. Hotfixes can be cumulative.

6.1.1 Hotfix installation

The installation procedure for a hotfix is the same as for a scheduled service pack update. Please see section 6.1.4.4 below.
